As a IT, Security and Quality Assurance Officer, you'll be responsible for a range of technical activities, while supporting the development, implementation and compliance the available applications in use. You'll also provide services such as information security, compliance management (FOI, DPA, etc.), data protection, and support for audits and scrutiny. And you'll work with other teams to oversee the operational service delivery, ensuring it meets the Council's needs. As someone who directly reports to the IT Security, Information and Quality Assurance Manager, you'll deputise and act as a contact point in their absence.

With experience of working in an ICT security role, you'll come to us with ITIL foundation or higher, or have and equivalent certification or training. You'll also be a Certified Information Security Manager, Professional or Practitioner, or equivalent. With responsibility for supporting transparent relationships, you must have good English literacy and numeracy skills. Due to the nature of the role, it's important you can work out of hours, including weekends, and provide an on-call service.
